<i>Courses on List I are ONLY the core curriculum classes as defined in the state framework. This means these courses are grade-level appropriate (non-remedial) and fulfill college preparatory requirements. ELD, Honors &amp; AP sections of the courses below are included.</i>	
<b>English</b>	All required college-prep (CP) English courses fulfilling the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade graduation requirements and meeting college entrance requirements, including Honors and AP.
<b>Social Sciences</b>	All college-prep (CP) courses which are in the core curriculum and fulfill the Social Science framework requirements, including Honors and AP.
<b>Mathematics</b>	First year college-prep (CP) Algebra or its equivalent, completed in one year; Math 1, 2, 3 (taken in the place of Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II); Geometry; Algebra II; and all math courses which require first year Algebra as a prerequisite, including Honors and AP.
<b>Science</b>	All college-prep (CP) courses which are in the core curriculum and fulfill the science framework requirements, and require Biology or Chemistry as prerequisites, including Honors and AP.
<b>Foreign Language</b>	All college-prep (CP) courses which include grammar and literature, including Honors and AP. *this includes American Sign Language

<i>Courses on List II meet elective requirements for graduation and integrate the following criteria: Intellectually and academically challenging material; substantial amounts of reading and writing; and critical thinking and problem-solving skills.</i>	
<b>English</b>	Journalism
<b>Social Sciences</b>	Psychology, Human Geography, Mexican-American Studies
<b>Mathematics</b>	Algebra I completed in more than one year
<b>Science</b>	Engineering, Forensic Science
<b>Fine Arts</b>	Art History, Music Theory
